RESOLUTION TO ADVANCE BICYCLE SAFETY AND TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE TOWN OF GULF STREAM, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, The Boca Raton Bicycle Club, Inc., members engage in bicycling as a viable and environmentally sound form of transportation and an excellent form of physical activity, social networking, charitable missions, safety awareness, and recreation; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation has advanced road designs and improvements on roadways and for bicycle and pedestrian facilities which have been unnecessarily abandoned in the Town of Gulf Stream, Florida along State Road A1A; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Gulf Stream has failed to support improvement of bicycle and pedestrian facilities, has failed to adequately enforce traffic laws and proper road patrol of the protection of the life and safety of pedestrians and cyclists, and has exhibited a pattern of disregard for pedestrians and cyclists safety; and

WHEREAS, the recognition of need and the implementation of simple roadway improvements and facilities such as bicycle lanes and road markings, including sharrows, signage alerting vehicles and cyclists to share the road, proper lighting, and community education, will raise awareness of bicycling and ultimately promote the safety, physical activity and healthy lifestyles by elevating bicycling as a more widely accepted choice of transportation, sport, tourism and recreation;

WHEREAS, the Boca Raton Bicycle Club supports projects to make bicycling more accessible and promotes comprehensive community education efforts aimed at improving bicycle safety; and

WHEREAS, the Boca Raton Bicycle Club supports expanding the designated or enhanced bicycle lane network within the Town of Gulf Stream,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY The Boca Raton Bicycle Club, assembled in regular session this 8th day January, 2024, The Boca Raton Bicycle Club shall offer its support and advocacy for transportation facilities and improvements along State Road A1A in the Town of Gulf Stream, Florida and educational efforts in order to enhance the awareness and safety for anyone using transportation facilities in the Town of Gulf Stream.
