P R O B A B L E	<p>On 12/15/2024, at 0742 hours, I was dispatched to 1400 N Ocean Blvd, Boca Raton, FL, in reference to a fatality crash. Upon arrival, I observed the victim, Felipe Soares-de-Moraes, face down within the NB shoulder of SR A1A. The other vehicle involved was identified as a Grey Chevy Equinox (FL RDVF37) located stationary upon the NB shoulder of SR A1A with a bicycle embedded within the front bumper. The driver of the Equinox, Thomas Vayianos, who was identified by his NJ DL was sitting at the rear of his vehicle.</p>							
	<p>A witness on the scene, Richard Raschdorf, advised that on 12/15/2024, around 0709 hours, he was riding his bicycle NB on SR A1A at approximately the 1200 block within the marked bicycle lane. Richard explained that he witnessed the Grey Equinox pass him "so closely he could touch the vehicle" NB on A1A. As the vehicle passed Richard observed the vehicle swerving within its lane entering the marked bicycle lane multiple times. Richard could see Felipe on his bicycle up ahead of him. Richard watched as the Equinox struck Felipe sending him airborne where he came to final rest within the NB shoulder of A1A. Richard arrived on the scene shortly, thereafter, called 911, and watched as Thomas exited the Equinox and stood outside the driver's door. Shortly thereafter police/ID arrived on scene.</p>							
	<p>Preliminary crash reconstruction revealed that Felipe was operating his bicycle upon the right half of the single travel lane northbound on SR A1A. The equinox's front right struck Felipe from the rear resulting in Felipe being thrown 65 feet and rolling/tumbling an additional 71 feet where he came to final rest.</p>							
C A U S E	<p>I walked over and spoke with Thomas. I introduced myself and asked for his name. Thomas responded by saying "I'm worried about the Hotel people" and seemed to be under the impression that the other officers on the scene including myself were "Hotel people". In speaking with Thomas, I observed that he had pinpoint pupils and would look through me</p>

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when trying to speak. Thomas had to be asked questions multiple times as he would either not answer the question at all or go off-topic with seemingly unrelated matters. I walked Thomas away from his vehicle to speak with him out in the open. As soon as he could no longer use his vehicle for support it became immediately apparent, he was unsteady on his feet and swayed while attempting to stand still.

I asked Thomas to explain everything he remembered occurring today up until his interaction with the police. Thomas advised he remembered putting his laptop in his vehicle from "the hotel". Thomas then began to explain an interaction he had with the leasing manager at "the hotel". I asked Thomas where the hotel is located to which he began to explain that his parents were paying for his rehab and as far as he knows he is currently located at "the hotel". In speaking with Thomas, it became apparent that he had no clue he had struck anyone. When I asked again if he remembered the crash Thomas began to explain an incident that occurred in Vermont where he "tapped someone".

After it became apparent that Thomas was not going to be able to provide any crash information, I explained to him that I had completed the crash investigation and read him his Miranda Warnings. Thomas indicated he understood and was willing to speak with me. While no longer covered under accident report privilege and post Miranda Thomas advised he had no idea he struck a bicyclist. Thomas explained he was currently taking Adderall, Vyvance, and Gabapentin. When asked why he was taking these controlled substances Thomas stated "I'm in rehab". Thomas advised he last consumed the substances "last night after midnight" and was currently under the impression it was 1030 as that was his check-out time from the hotel. Based upon the combination of pre and post-stop indicators I requested Thomas participate in Field Sobriety Exercises (FSEs) to which he complied.

The FSEs were conducted as follows.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN)

The defendant identified the stimulus as red. The defendant had equal pupil size and equal tracking in both eyes. The defendant's eyes continued to jump as he attempted to follow the stimulus. In conducting the exercise, I was able to observe a Lack of Smooth and Vertical Nystagmus. While giving the instructions the defendant continued to sway and was unable to stay in place.

Lack of convergence (LOC)

The defendant had equal pupil size. While conducting the exercises a lack of convergence was observed. The defendant continued to sway.

**Walk and Turn**

The surface was flat and hard. The defendant attempted to do the exercise with shoes. The line used was a painted white line. I made sure the defendant both knew the line he would be using and the color of that line. I began the exercise by instructing and demonstrating to the defendant how to complete the exercise. While giving instructions the defendant lost balance several times and failed to stay in the starting position. In conducting the exercise, the defendant walked an improper number of steps, made an improper turn, walked off the line, failed to walk Heal-to-Toe, and stopped to steady himself.

**One Leg Stand**

The surface was flat and hard. The defendant attempted to do the exercise with shoes. The defendant indicated multiple times he understood the instructions. When instructed to begin the defendant walked forward several steps before turning around and walking back to his original position failing to even attempt the exercises as demonstrated.

**Romberg Alphabet.**



The defendant was provided the instructions and indicated he understood. When instructed to begin the defendant began counting down from 5 and never even attempted the alphabet. While attempting the exercise the defendant continued to sway.

Due to the totality of the circumstances and my training/experience, I felt the defendant was unable to perform simple tasks during the exercises due to being impaired. I feel the defendant is too impaired to operate a motor vehicle safely and this impairment was a primary contributing factor to the crash and subsequent fatality.

Due to the sever nature of the incident a blood sample was collected under exigency from Thomas. The sample was collected by the Boca Raton Fire department. BRFD Lieutenant Eric Hanks collected the sample within their ambulance (Rescue 3). The sample was submitted to BRPD evidence. Based upon the above information Thomas did commit the offense of FSS 316.193(3C3A) DUI Manslaughter with a vehicle causing death to a human and was placed under arrest at 0953 hours.

Thomas was transported to Boca Regional hospital for medical clearance. While at the hospital a search warrant was obtained for the collection and testing of Thomas's blood for the purposes of identifying any chemical or controlled substances. This sample was collected by medical staff and submitted to BRPD evidence.

Thomas was transported to Palm Beach County jail.
